



INSTRUCTIONS TO PARENTS

- 1. Kindly check the haircut, uniform and punctuality of your ward before sending to school.
- 2. Please see that your ward carries text/exercise books according to Time Table for that day. Don't allow extra books to be carried to the school.
- 3. Kindly inform the school authorities if there is any change in the address or contact number.
- 4. Encourage your child to take a balanced interest in the studies, curricular activities and sports.
- 5. Students are not allowed to bring transistors, wrist watches, cameras, calculators, mobile phones, blade sand knives etc. to the school.
- 6. The name, class and section of the pupil should be clearly marked on all the belongings of the students.
- 7. If the child is absent from school, he/she must make up for all the work he/she has missed.
- 8. Parents should send a letter of absence of the child on the day of his/her joining the school.
- 9. Students must bring nutritious food in an eat and well packed tiffin.
- 10. They must bring a clean napkin and water in a clean water-bottle.
- 11. Parents should be present on all the days of P.T. M without fail.
- 12. Parents are requested not to visit the students in the classroom without the prior permission of the Principal.
- 13. Parents can contact the Principal during school hours for any grievances.
- 14. Parents should make sure that the child reaches the school on time before the commencement of the assembly.
- 15. Parents should attend to the calls from the school seriously and respond accordingly.
- 16. Parents are requested to pay the school fees on time.
- 17. Parents should cooperate with the school authorities in following and supporting the system, rules and regulations and directions of the school.

RULES CONCERNING ABSENCE AND WITHDRAWAL

- Parents should give prior written application for leave to the school and plausible reason only.
- Any absence of a student for more than ten days without intimation amounts to deletion of name from rolls. The student will then have to seek readmission depending on availability of seats.
- Ever absence (due to sickness or otherwise) must be entered briefly on the Non-Attendance and Leave Record Page and signed by parents guardians.
- A Student returning to school after suffering from an infectious or contagious disease should produce a doctor's certificate permitting him/her to attend school. Students suffering from the following diseases must observe the prescribed period of quarantine before returning to class.

a) Chicken Pox : Till complete falling of scrabs.

b) Measles : Two weeks after the rash disappears.

c) Mumps : Until the swelling has gone. About one month.

d) Whooping cough : Six weeks

e) Conjunctivitis: Till infection subsides

f) Covid -19 : Till the RT-PCR test is negative and Covid Vaccination is done

WITHDRAWALS

- One clear month's notice in writing or a month's fee in lieu of such notice must be given before a pupil can be withdrawn.
- For withdrawals, parents must ensure that the transfer Certificate must be taken within three months from the date of the request. In case of lapse on the parent's part to claim above mentioned within the stipulated time of three months. It becomes mandatory for the parents to pay the Quarterly tuition fees for their ward(s) at the time of receiving the documents.
- Transfer certificate are not issued until all dues of the school are settled.
- Those who leave the school in the month of May must in all cases pay the fees for the month of June.
- Once the Transfer Certificate is applied for, no holding of the Transfer Certificate is permitted.
- If no notice of withdrawal is given, full fees of all the months of absence will be charged along with late fee. If the name of the pupil is on the roll even for one day of the month, the fee for the entire month will be charged.

SCHOOL FEE

The school fee is to be paid for all classes only on the 10th April, July, October, January

- Late fee charges: Rs.50/- on the first day after the due date mentioned above and thereafter Rs.10/- per day.
- Cheque Dishonour Charges: Rs.300/-
- On Dishonour of Cheque, Parents should submit a fresh cheque including:
- Cheque return fine of Rs.300/- and
- Late fee charge applicable
- Fees will be accepted by local cheque/DD only having the child's name, class, section, telephone no, mentioned on the reverse side of the Cheque/DD.
- Cheque should be in the favour of NEW BOMBAY CITY SCHOOL, CBSE.
- Parents should give separate cheque for each child in case of more than one child studying in the school. Postdated Cheque will not be accepted.


TRANSPORT
